THE ALCOHOLIC LIQUORS SALE CONTROL ACT AMENDMENT BILL.

Mr. McNAB, in Committee, to move the following amendments:—

Section 16. To strike out all the words after “hereby,” and insert the following: “repealed, and the following substituted in lieu thereof:—

“No bottle license or New-Zealand-wine license shall be granted or renewed after the commencement of this Act.”

New clause.

The determination of the electors of the Clutha Licensing District, at the poll taken under “The Alcoholic Liquors Sale Control Act, 1893,” in the month of March, one thousand eight hundred and ninety-four, shall, for the purpose of subsection one of section twenty-two of the said Act, be deemed and taken to have been a determination in manner required by the Licensing Acts that no licenses be granted in such district, and the provisions of the said section shall apply and be deemed to have applied to the said district accordingly.
