CANTERBURY COLLEGE BILL.

Mr. BUDDO, in Committee, to move the following amendment:—

Clause 6, line 37: To omit all the words after “follows,” down to and including “country Committees,” in line 38, for the purpose of adding the following: “One by the Governor in Council, two by the Agricultural and Pastoral Associations, three by Committees in the Christchurch electorate; the electorates of Ashley, Kaiapoi, Selwyn, Avon, Ellesmere, Lyttelton, Riccarton, Ashburton, Rangitata, Pareora, Timaru, and Waitaki shall each return one, elected by the Committees.”

ALCOHOLIC LIQUORS SALE CONTROL ACT AMENDMENT BILL.

Mr. CARNELL, in Committee, to move the addition of the following new clause:—

. No removal of any license shall be granted unless and until a memorial, signed by a majority of the registered electors resident within a radius of two hundred yards in a borough, or, if in a county, one mile, from the house proposed to be licensed, shall be presented to the Licensing Committee. The Licensing Committee shall not, however, be bound to grant such removal.
