CANTERBURY AGRICULTURAL AND PASTORAL ASSOCIATION EMPOWERING BILL (No. 2).

Mr. SANDFORD, in Committee, to move the following new clause:—

And whereas it is expedient that opportunity should be afforded to the Borough of Sydenham to purchase the said land, be it enacted as aforesaid: This Act shall not come into operation till the *first* day of *March*, one thousand eight hundred and ninety-four.

ALCOHOLIC LIQUORS SALE CONTROL BILL.

Sir R. STOUT, in Committee, to move the following amendments:—

In section 13, line 1, to omit the words "The Returning Officer in every Licensing District," and insert in lieu thereof the words "the Governor."

In section 15, subsection (3), line 2, to omit the words "of three-fifths;" and in subsection (4), line 4, to omit the words "three-fifths," and substitute therefor "a majority;" and to omit the words at end of the subsection, "but subject in either of the above cases as follows," and also all the rest of the words in section 15.

In section 16, line 5, to omit the word "exceeding," and substitute therefor the words "less than."
