### AUCKLAND METROPOLITAN MILK AMENDMENT BILL.

Mr. SAVAGE, in Committee, to move the following amendments:—

Clause 6, in line 25: to insert after the word “ follows ” the following:—

Section eight of the principal Act is hereby amended as follows:—

(1) By omitting paragraphs (a) and (b) of subsection one, and inserting in lieu thereof the following paragraphs:—

(a) An election shall be held to elect three members of the Board to represent the City of Auckland:

(b) An election shall be held to elect two members of the Board to represent the other constituent areas of the district.

(2) By omitting subsection three, and inserting the following subsection in lieu thereof:—

“(3) (a) Every such election shall be held under and subject to the provisions of the Local Elections and Polls Act, 1925, and the provisions of that Act, including the penal provisions thereof and the provisions relating to disputed elections, shall, so far as applicable and so far as consistent with this Act, apply accordingly.

(b) The roll of the electors of the City of Auckland shall be used and deemed to be the roll of electors for the purposes of paragraph (a) of subsection one hereof and the rolls of the electors of the several constituent areas mentioned in paragraph (b) of subsection one hereof taken together, or so much of those rolls as relates to lands within the district, as the case may require, shall be deemed to be the roll of the electors of the other constituent areas for the purposes of said paragraph (b).

(c) It shall be the duty of the Clerk of the local authority of each constituent area whenever requested so to do by the Board to supply to the Board a certified roll of the electors of such constituent area or any defined portion thereof, together with as many copies thereof as the Board may require.

(d) The Board shall pay the sum of one shilling for each such copy.”
