ANIMALS PROTECTION ACT AMENDMENT BILL.

Mr. Lang, in Committee, to move the addition of the following new clause:

When game may be taken without license.

Any person in bona fide occupation of any land not being Crown lands, or any one person authorised by him in writing under his hand, for the day or days mentioned in such writing, may take or kill game or native game upon any lands so occupied by such first-mentioned person within the periods allowed under this Act, and subject to the conditions for the time being imposed on holders of licenses under this Act for the taking or killing of such game

respectively, and shall not be liable to any penalty for so doing.
