ANIMALS PROTECTION AMENDMENT BILL.

Mr. WITTY, in Committee, to move the following amendments:—

Clause 4: To insert after the words "such season" the words "for exhibition purposes only."

To add the following new clause:—

7. Notwithstanding anything in any Act it shall be lawful for any person in any part of New Zealand to kill or otherwise destroy hares, weasels, or stoats:

Provided that the Governor in Council may on the recommendation of an acclimatization society suspend, within the district of that society, the operation of this section with respect to weasels and stoats.
