ACCIDENT REHABILITATION AND COMPENSATION INSURANCE AMENDMENT BILL (NO. 3)

Proposed Motion to Divide Bill into 2 Bills

Rt. Hon. W. F. BIRCH, in Committee, to move as follows:

That Part I be a separate Bill, and that for *clause 2* there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and Short Title clause:

An Act to amend the Accident Rehabilitation and Compensation Insurance Act 1992

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

1. Short Title and commencement—(1) This Act may be cited as the Accident Rehabilitation and Compensation Insurance Amendment Act (No. 3) 1993, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Accident Rehabilitation and Compensation Insurance Act 1992 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

(2) Except as provided in sections 3 (4), 4 (5), 5 (2), 6 (3), 8 (3), and 29 (3) of this Act, this Act shall come into force on the 1st day of July 1993.

That Part II be a separate Bill, and that for clause 46 there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and Short Title clause:

An Act to amend the Health and Safety in Employment Act 1992

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

1. Short Title and commencement—(1) This Act may be cited as the Health and Safety in Employment Amendment Act 1993, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Health and Safety in Employment Act 1992 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

(2) This Act shall come into force on the 1st day of July 1993.
