# **Aquaculture Reform Bill**

Proposed motion to divide Bill into 7 Bills

Hon David Benson-Pope, in Committee, to move as follows:

That the enacting words, clauses 1 and 2, Part 1, and Schedule 1 be a separate Bill, and that for the enacting words, clauses 1 and 2, and the Part 1 heading there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

#### The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

- 1 Title
- (1) This Act is the Resource Management Amendment Act 2004.
- (2) In this Act, the Resource Management Act 1991<sup>1</sup> is called "the principal Act".

#### 2 Commencement

This Act comes into force on 1 January 2005.

That Part 2 and Schedule 2A be a separate Bill, and that for the Part 2 heading and clause 36 there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

# The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

- 1 Title
- (1) This Act is the Fisheries Amendment Act 2004.
- (2) In this Act, the Fisheries Act 1996<sup>2</sup> is called "the principal Act".

#### 2 Commencement

This Act comes into force on 1 January 2005.

That *Part 3* be a separate Bill, and that for the *Part 3* heading and *clause 54* there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

- (1) This Act is the Conservation Amendment Act 2004.
- (2) In this Act, the Conservation Act 1987<sup>3</sup> is called "the principal Act".

#### 2 Commencement

This Act comes into force on 1 January 2005.

That Part 4 be a separate Bill, and that for the Part 4 heading and clause 56 there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

# The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

#### 1 Title

- (1) This Act is the Biosecurity Amendment Act 2004.
- (2) In this Act, the Biosecurity Act 1993<sup>4</sup> is called "the principal Act".

#### 2 Commencement

This Act comes into force on 1 January 2005.

That Part 5 and Schedules 3 and 4 be a separate Bill, and that for the Part 5 heading there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

#### The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

#### 1 Title

This Act is the Maori Commercial Aquaculture Claims Settlement Act **2004**.

#### 2 Commencement

Except as provided in **section 105B(4)**, this Act comes into force on 1 January **2005**.

That *Part 6* be a separate Bill, and that for the *Part 6* heading and *clause 106* there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

# The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

#### 1 Title

- (1) This Act is Te Ture Whenua Maori Amendment Act 2004.
- (2) In this Act, Te Ture Whenua Maori Act 1993<sup>5</sup> is called "the principal Act".

#### 2 Commencement

This Act comes into force on 1 January 2005.

That Part 7 be a separate Bill, and that for the Part 7 heading there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

# The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

# 1 Title

This Act is the Aquaculture Reform (Repeals and Transitional Provisions) Act **2004**.

#### 2 Commencement

- (1) **Section 140** comes into force on a date to be appointed by the Governor-General by Order in Council.
- (2) The rest of this Act comes into force on 1 January 2005.
