Aviation Security Legislation Bill

Proposed amendments

Hon Harry Duynhoven, in Committee, to move the following amendments:

Clause 6: new section 12(5A)

To omit “With” (line 16 on page 7) and substitute “Subject to **subsection (5B)**, with”.

Clause 6: new section 12

To insert the following subsection after *subsection (5A)* (after line 21 on page 7):

“(5B) Despite **subsection (5A)**, with respect to a person searched under **subsection (1)**, a member of the police, an aviation officer, a Customs officer, or an agent of the carrier authorised by the carrier for the purpose may not use an aid or device that produces an unclothed image of the person.

Explanatory note

This Supplementary Order Paper amends the Aviation Security Legislation Bill.

The amendment to *clause 6: new section 12(5A)* omits “With” and substitutes “Subject to **subsection (5B)**, with”.

The amendment to *clause 6: new section 12* inserts *new subsection (5B)*, which clarifies that with respect to a person searched under *new section 12(1)*, a member of the police, an aviation officer, a Customs officer, or an agent of the carrier authorised by the carrier for the purpose may not use an aid or device that produces an unclothed image of the person.
