That the enacting words, *clauses 1 and 2*, and *Part 1* be a separate Bill, and that for the enacting words, *clauses 1 and 2*, and the *Part 1* heading there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

- 1 **Title** This Act is the Aviation Crimes Amendment Act **2007**.
- 2 Commencement
- (1) **Sections 3, 4(2) and (3), 5, and 6** come into force on the day after the date on which this Act receives the Royal assent.
- (2) The rest of this Act comes into force on a date to be appointed by the Governor-General by Order in Council; and 1 or more Orders in Council may be made bringing different provisions into force on different dates.

That *Part 2* and the *Schedule* be a separate Bill, and that for the *Part 2* heading there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

1 Title

This Act is the Civil Aviation Amendment Act 2007.

- (1) Sections 9, 10(2) and (3), 13, 17(2), 18, 19(1), 21, 22, and 24(1) and (2) come into force on the day after the date on which this Act receives the Royal assent.
- (2) The rest of this Act comes into force on a date to be appointed by the Governor-General by Order in Council; and 1 or more Orders in Council may be made bringing different provisions into force on different dates.
