Aviation Security Legislation Bill

Proposed motion to divide Bill into 2 Bills

Hon Harry Duynhoven, in Committee, to move as follows:

That the enacting words, *clauses 1 and 2*, and *Part 1* be a separate Bill, and that for the enacting words, *clauses 1 and 2*, and the *Part 1* heading there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

1 Title

This Act is the Aviation Crimes Amendment Act **2007**.

2 Commencement

- (1) **Sections 3, 4(2) and (3), 5, and 6** come into force on the day after the date on which this Act receives the Royal assent.
- (2) The rest of this Act comes into force on a date to be appointed by the Governor-General by Order in Council; and 1 or more Orders in Council may be made bringing different provisions into force on different dates.

That *Part 2* and the *Schedule* be a separate Bill, and that for the *Part 2* heading there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

1 Title

This Act is the Civil Aviation Amendment Act **2007**.

2 Commencement

- (1) **Sections 9, 10(2) and (3), 13, 17(2), 18, 19(1), 21, 22, and 24(1) and (2)** come into force on the day after the date on which this Act receives the Royal assent.
- (2) The rest of this Act comes into force on a date to be appointed by the Governor-General by Order in Council; and 1 or more Orders in Council may be made bringing different provisions into force on different dates.
