AID TO PUBLIC WORKS AND LAND SETTLEMENT BILL.

Mr. MONTGOMERY, in Committee, to move the following new clauses :—

“The Lands Improvements and Native Lands Acquisition Act, 1894,” is hereby amended as follows: Clause three is repealed, and the following clause inserted in its place:—

“The Minister shall, within ten days of the opening of each session, lay before Parliament estimates of the cost of such of the aforesaid works as he proposes to construct out of the funds available and appropriated therefor as hereinafter provided, showing in each case the Crown land which is proposed to be improved by such work.”

In case any Native land purchased under the authority of this Act or “The Lands Improvement and Native Lands Acquisition Act, 1894,” shall be sold, the proceeds of such sale shall be paid to the credit of the Native Lands Purchase Account, and no part of such proceeds shall be paid into the Consolidated Fund.
