ACCESS TRAINING SCHEME BILL Proposed Amendment

Hon. P. B. Goff, in Committee, to move the following amendment: Clause 84: To omit this clause from page 4, and substitute the following clause:

**8A.** Employees of training providers, etc., excluded from membership of Councils—(1) This section applies to any person who is an employee or officer of any person or body that is seeking approval or is currently approved to provide training under the Scheme.

(2) No person to whom this section applies shall be appointed, or be entitled to retain office, as a member of a Council, or as a deputy for any member of a Council, unless the Minister forms the opinion that the appointment or retention of office is not likely to involve that person in a conflict of interest.

## **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

This amendment relates to the persons who are excluded from membership of Regional Employment and Access Councils.

The Bill presently provides that no employee or officer of a training provider, or of a prospective training provider, can be appointed or retain office as a member of a REAC or as a deputy for any member of a REAC.

This amendment provides that such persons will be excluded from membership unless the Minister forms the opinion that the appointment or retention of office is not likely to involve that person in a conflict of interest.
