BUSH AND SWAMP GROWN LANDS SETTLEMENT BILL.

Mr. McNAB (for Mr. Moss), in Committee, to move the following new clause:—

On application
for land,
estimated cost
of survey to be
deposited.

3. Should any swamp or bush or scrub land applied for under "The Mining Districts Land Occupation Act, 1894," be unsurveyed, the applicant shall, within thirty days after the approval of his application, deposit the estimated cost of surveying the area applied for, otherwise the application shall be deemed cancelled and withdrawn. The money so deposited may, at the discretion of the Minister, be treated as rent paid in advance, and in such case no further payment shall be required on account of rent until the beginning of the half-year subsequent to the period for which such deposit has satisfied the full rent in advance.

IMPOUNDING ACT AMENDMENT BILL (No. 2).

Mr. HOUSTON, in Committee, to move the following new clause:—

3. The second paragraph of section fourteen of the principal Act is hereby amended by inserting next after the word "fenced," in the first line, the words "or unfenced."
