BROADCASTING BILL.

FURTHER amendments proposed by His Excellency the Governor-General:—

Clause 14: To omit the clause, and substitute the following new clause:—

Board to take
over existing
stations.

14A. (1) The Board, if and when required by the Minister so to do, shall acquire from him, at such price and upon such terms and conditions as he thinks fit, any broadcasting stations, plant, and other assets that the Minister may acquire from the Radio Broadcasting Company of New Zealand, Limited, pursuant to agreements made between the Minister and the said Company, on the eighteenth day of July, nineteen hundred and twenty-five, and the sixteenth day of December, nineteen hundred and twenty-six, respectively.

Validation of
agreements.

(2) The said agreements are hereby declared to be valid, and any payment to be made by the Minister to the said Company in terms thereof shall be paid out of the Post Office Account without further appropriation than this section.
