CUSTOMS ACTS AMENDMENT BILL.

Rev. Mr. CARR, in Committee, to move to add the following new clause:—

Duties may be
increased.

9A. If at any time after the first March, nineteen hundred and thirty-two, the flour-millers in New Zealand reduce the price of flour by not less than ten shillings net per ton, in addition to the amount of the reduction consequent upon the duties levied herein, the Governor-General may by Order in Council increase the duties imposed by this Act by an amount not exceeding threepence per bushel on wheat and twelve shillings per ton on flour. Any such Order in Council may be at any time in like manner revoked.
