COUNTIES BILL.

Mr. HOBBS, in Committee, to move the following amendments:—

Clause 6. After line 31 insert—

The Whangaroa riding of the Mongonui County is hereby constituted a new county by the name of the Whangaroa County as on and from the night next preceding the day on which this Act comes into force. This Act shall be deemed a special Act within meaning of section *twenty-three* for the purpose of creating the aforesaid new county, and the provisions of sections *twenty-seven* to *thirty-four*, both inclusive, shall apply in respect to the new county and the Mongonui County, of which it formed a part.

The Hon. Sir R. STOUT, in Committee, to move the following amendments:—

Clause 31, line 50. Omit “such Council;” insert “of the Council of either the original or new county.”

Clause 47 to be omitted.

133A. All moneys owing by the Corporation of the county shall be paid in cash or by cheque, and not otherwise. All moneys paid or purporting to be paid by the Council by promissory note, or bill, shall be deemed to have been moneys unlawfully paid within the meaning of section *one hundred and eighty*, and may be recovered in manner as in the said section mentioned.

Clause 180, line 26. After “incurred” insert “the Controller aforesaid, or”

Clause 203, line 14. After “costs of suit” insert “by the Controller and Auditor-General, or”

Before clause 280 insert—

The Council shall be a local Board of Health under “The Public Health Act, 1876,” and shall exercise the jurisdiction of such Board over all parts of the county which are not included either within a road district or town district; and with the consent of the Road Board or Town Board thereof may also exercise the jurisdiction of a local Board of Health within road districts and town districts in order to provide uniform administration and economy.
