## NOTICE OF MOTION.

1. Hon. Mr. REID to move, when in Committee on the Charitable Institutions Bill, the following amendments:—

### *New Clauses, to follow Section 15.*

Where the Council of any county or borough shall appropriate any of the corporate funds as a contribution towards any institution, then such Council shall have the right to nominate in each year managers of such institutions in proportion to the amounts so appropriated, and so that the number of managers so to be nominated by the Council shall bear to the whole number of managers of the institution the same proportion as the sum appropriated in any year by the Council as aforesaid shall bear to the whole amount of the contributions actually received by the institution during the previous year.

The first nomination of managers by any Council contributing shall be made at the annual election of managers occurring next after the payment of such contribution, and shall be continued from year to year in the same proportion, by the nomination of the same or other persons, until the amount of the contribution appropriated by the Council shall be either increased or decreased or shall cease, in which case the proportion of managers to be nominated by the Council shall, at the annual election occurring next after any such change in the amount of the contribution, be either increased or decreased accordingly, or shall cease altogether.

Page 4, line 13. After the word "elections," insert the words "for appointing committees of contributors to advise and assist the managers, for defining the powers and duties of such committees, for appointing governors and life governors, and for fixing their qualifications rights and privileges, and generally."

In section 25, line 3. To substitute the word "received" for the word "raised"; and in the fourth line, after the word "donations," to add the following words:—"exclusive of any income received from rents or any investment of the funds of the institution."

### *New Clause, to follow Section 25.*

The treasurer of every institution shall, on or before the fifteenth day of January and July in every year, send to the Colonial Treasurer a return showing the total amount of subscriptions, receipts, and donations, described in the foregoing section, actually received by the institution during the six months immediately preceding the first day of January and July in every year; and the subsidy payable out of the Consolidated Fund to any institution shall be estimated from the amounts stated in such returns, and shall be paid by the Colonial Treasurer to such institutions half-yearly within thirty days after the receipt by him of the said returns.

Every such half-yearly return shall be certified by a declaration to be made by the president of the institution before a Justice of the Peace, and appended to the return.

### *New Clause, to follow Section 26.*

The treasurer of every institution shall, on or before the thirty-first day of March in every year, send to the Colonial Treasurer a copy of the balance sheet of the accounts of the institution, signed by the president, for the year ending on the thirty-first day of December previous, together with such other accounts and particulars as the Colonial Treasurer directs; and the same shall be laid before Parliament within ten days after its first sitting thereafter.
