COUNTIES VEHICLE-LICENSING BILL.

Mr. McLACHLAN to move, That the Counties Vehicle-licensing Bill be recommitted for the consideration of the following amendment:—

In section 8, line 19, after the word “Act,” to strike out all the words down to the word “offence,” in line 26, for the purpose of inserting the following words: “and the provisions of subsection one of section two of ‘The Police Offences Act Amendment Act, 1890,’ shall not apply within the district of a County Council or other local authority having power to make by-laws for regulating the conditions on which traction-engines shall be allowed to pass along roads or over bridges.”

Mr. BUDDO, in Committee, to move the following new clause:—

That, unless the average rateable value of lands exceeds three pounds per acre in any county, nothing contained in this Act shall be deemed to confer on any local authority any further power of making by-laws for the purpose of licensing vehicles (other than traction-engines as provided by section *eight* hereof).
