

SUPPLEMENTARY ORDER PAPER.

HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES.

Mr. J. E. BROWN, in Committee on the Canterbury Waste Lands Bill, to move the insertion of the following new clause:—

The holder of any pre-emptive right may at any time abandon such pre-emptive right by notification to the Waste Lands Board of his wish to do so, and in the event of the land being purchased he shall be entitled to remove all improvements thereon; or in case of the removal of the improvements for which such pre-emptive right was granted, the rights of pre-emption shall be deemed to be forfeited and determined.
