ELECTORAL ACTS AMENDMENT BILL.

Mr. Hatch, in Committee, to move the insertion of the following new clause after clause 3:—

3A. Every candidate for election as a member of the House of Representatives shall, at the time of nomination and before he shall be proposed for election, deposit with the Returning Officer the sum of ten pounds, to be returned to him after the election, if he shall have polled as many votes at the election as shall equal in number one-fifth of the smallest number of votes upon which any candidate has been elected; but otherwise, to be forfeited and applied in and towards defraying the expenses of the election.
