ELECTIVE EXECUTIVE BILL.

Hon. Major STEWARD, in Committee, to move the addition of the following new clause:—

Date of coming
into operation
of Act.

20. Section *sixteen* hereof and this section shall take effect so soon as the Governor's assent to this Act shall be given; but the remainder of this Act shall not come into operation until such date as may be fixed by Order in Council, and gazetted in the *New Zealand Gazette*, after a referendum shall have been made to the electors of the colony, and a vote taken thereon in every electorate, or unless upon such referendum a majority of all the votes polled shall be in favour of this Act being brought into force; and such referendum shall be held and taken within three months of the termination of the present session of Parliament.
