ELECTRIC-POWER BOARDS BILL.

AMENDMENTS proposed by His Excellency the Governor-General:—

Clause 64, subclause (3): To omit the words "one pound," and substitute the words "ten shillings."

Clause 68, subclause (1): To omit the words "within twelve months after the first election of the Board," and substitute the words "before the Board commences the supply of electrical energy, or within three years after the first election of the Board, whichever period is the less."

Clause 68, subclause (2): To omit from paragraph (a) the words "of twelve months."

Clause 75: To add the following subclause:—

(3.) If the Board or any member or officer of the Board wilfully makes default in complying with the requirements of this section, or of any regulations for the time being in force thereunder, the Chairman of the Board and every member or officer of the Board whose duty it was to comply with any such requirements shall, so long as such default continues, be guilty of a continuing offence and shall, on summary conviction for any such offence, be jointly and severally liable to a fine of *fifty* pounds.
