FACTORIES AMENDMENT BILL.

Hon. Mr. HALL-JONES, in Committee, to move the following new clause:—

4. (1.) Where in any town district or borough having a population of less than ten thousand Saturday is found to be an inconvenient day for the weekly half-holiday prescribed by section thirty-three of the principal Act in businesses coming within the principal Act, and also "The Shops and Shop-assistants Act, 1894," the Town Board or Council may from time to time, by special order, substitute another working-day in the week for the half-holiday in lieu of Saturday in respect of such businesses.

(2.) So long as such special order continues in force the provisions of the principal Act relating to the half-holiday on Saturday shall apply to the half-holiday on the substituted working-day in respect of such businesses.
