## FACTORIES BILL.

Hon. Mr. REEVES, in Committee, to move the following amendments:—

Add to end of last paragraph of section 53: "and shall be liable to a penalty not exceeding *five* pounds for every day during which such non-compliance continues."

Add as a paragraph to section 55: "No person shall employ in any factory or workroom any woman during the four weeks immediately after her confinement."

Add at end of last paragraph of section 56: "Provided, however, that if in any factory or workroom such permission is granted by the Inspector and acted on by the occupier, then in that factory or workroom all women and young persons shall likewise begin work at that hour, to the intent that all women and young persons may quit such factory or workroom at the one time."
