FERTILISERS BILL

*Proposed Amendments*

RIGHT HON. MR MACINTYRE, in Committee, to move the following amendments:

*Clause 1 (2)*: To omit the words "1st day of December 1982", and substitute the words "a date appointed by the Governor-General by Order in Council".

*Clause 23*: To insert in *subclause (1)*, after the definition of the term "existing fertilisers", the following definitions:

"First date" means the day 3 months after the commencement of this Act:

"Second date" means the day 6 months after the commencement of this Act:

To omit from *subclauses (4) and (5) (a)* the words "1st day of March 1983", and substitute, in each case, the words "first date".

To omit from *subclauses (5) and (6) (b)* the words "1st day of June 1983", and substitute, in each case, the words "second date".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

These amendments provide for the Bill to come into force on a date appointed by the Governor-General by Order in Council (at present the Bill provides for a commencement date of 1 December 1982), and consequentially amend the transitional provisions contained in *clause 23*.
