FINANCE BILL (No. 4).

The Hon. Mr. DOWNIE STEWART, in Committee, to move the following amendments:—

Clause 40: To add the following subclause:—

(4) This section shall be deemed to have come into force on the first day of April, nineteen hundred and thirty-one.

To insert, in Part V, after clause 46, the following new clause:—

Extension of
time within
which
preparation of
town-planning
schemes must be
completed.

46A. (1) Section thirteen of the Town-planning Act, 1926, as amended by section three of the Town-planning Amendment Act, 1929, is hereby further amended by omitting from subsection one the words "nineteen hundred and thirty-two", and substituting the words "nineteen hundred and thirty-seven".

(2) Section three of the Town-planning Amendment Act, 1929, is hereby repealed.
