

## SUPPLEMENTARY ORDER PAPER.

### HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES.

FISHERIES CONSERVATION ACT AMENDMENT BILL (No. 2).

Hon. Major STEWARD, in Committee, to move the following amendments :—

Clause 2: In line 12, next after the word "colony," to insert the words "or for any purpose relating to fishing or to the accommodation of anglers."

Clause 6: In line 20 to strike out the word "and," and insert in lieu thereof the words "the issue of free licenses to pupils of schools"; and to add at the end of line 22, next after the word "license," the words "and to empower the refusal of licenses to persons convicted of breaches of any Act relating to fishing or of any regulation made thereunder or under this Act."

To insert new clause :—

2A. It shall be lawful for any acclimatisation society to expend moneys in the purchase of land for camping-grounds for anglers, and in the erection thereon, or on any lands vested in such society, of necessary buildings for their accommodation, and in otherwise providing for their convenience.
