FISHERIES CONSERVATION ACT AMENDMENT BILL.

Mr. BARCLAY, in Committee, to move the addition of the following new clause:—

License-holder
may traverse
bed of stream.

The holder of a license issued under regulations made under the principal Act and this Act shall, while such license continues in force, be entitled to enter and traverse the bed of any stream over which such license extends, and any land within one chain of such stream not being part of a garden or orchard; and no such entry shall be deemed to be a trespass on the lands of any riparian owner.
