#### FISHERIES CONSERVATION ACT.

Mr. BARCLAY, in Committee, to move the addition of the following new clause :—

Fishing-rights  
not to be sold.

No sale of fishing-rights or the right to fish in any stream or river running or flowing past or through privately owned land shall be legal or binding, and every such sale or contract for such sale shall be absolutely void and of no effect whatever; and no person shall make any charge or take or receive any money or other good or valuable consideration from any person for a grant of the right or permission to fish in any such stream or river as aforesaid, or for the right or permission to enter upon any land for the purpose of fishing as aforesaid.
