FAIR RENT BILL.

Captain RUSSELL to move, in Committee, the following addition to clause 23:—

“Provided, however, that, should the fair rent, as determined by the Board, in the opinion of the tenant be greater than he can pay, he shall be allowed to determine the lease, and shall not in consequence be liable to any action for breach of contract.”

INDUSTRIAL CONCILIATION AND ARBITRATION BILL.

Mr. PALMER, in Committee, to move the following proviso at the end of clause 5:—

“Provided always that such counsel or solicitor, when he is precluded by this section from appearing as aforesaid, may appoint some other person not a barrister or solicitor to appear and act in all matters in such dispute in lieu of such counsel or solicitor.”
