FRIENDLY SOCIETIES ACT AMENDMENT.

Mr. F. H. FRASER, in Committee, to move the following new clauses:—

3. Subsection three of section thirteen of the said Act is hereby repealed, and, in lieu thereof, it is hereby enacted that Customs duties shall not be chargeable on regalia, emblems, certificates, banners, letter- and note-paper with printed friendly society headings, envelopes bearing a friendly society's seal, account-books specially printed and ruled for friendly societies' use, seal-presses, and framed dispensations, being the property of and specially imported by or for any society or registered branch.

4. To section thirteen add subsection fourteen: The benefit funds of a society or registered branch shall not be subject to taxation.
