### GAMING AND LOTTERIES BILL.

Mr. DAVEY, in Committee, to move the following new clause:—

Dividends paid  
must include  
sixpences.

A. (1.) It shall be the duty of all racing clubs using the totalisator to pay out (after deducting the usual ten per centum commission), by way of dividend, all moneys received from investments on the totalisator:

Provided that it shall not be necessary to pay out fractions of a shilling, other than one-half.

(2.) Any breach of this section shall be an offence, and the penalty shall be a fine of not more than *one* hundred pounds for each offence.

Reduction in  
number of days  
racing.

B. On and after the first day of September, nineteen hundred and eight, the number of days on which the totalisator shall be used at all race meetings shall be reduced by one-sixth of the number existing at the time of the passing of this Act.
