Contingent Notice of Motion.

1. On the motion that the Governor's Salary Bill be committed, Mr. STAFFORD to move :---

That this House is of opinion that in lieu of the salary, allowances for the Governor's establishment, and other expenses hitherto paid, the salary of the Governor of New Zealand should be Seven Thousand Pounds per annum; and that no further charges whatever for His Excellency's establishment, travelling or other expenses, be borne upon or paid out of the public revenues of New Zealand, except the charges for furnishing the reception rooms, and the offices used by the Governor and his staff at Government House; and that on Monday, the 8th day of September, this House do resolve itself into Committee of the whole, to consider of giving leave to introduce a Bill to give effect to the above Resolution.
