HOSPITAL ACTS AMENDMENT BILL

Proposed motion to divide Bill into 2 Bills

Hon. Dr MICHAEL BASSETT, in Committee, to move the following amendments:

That *clauses 2 to 8* be a separate Bill, and that for *clause 2* there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and clause:

An Act to amend the Area Health Boards Act 1983

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1. Short Title and commencement—(1) This Act may be cited as the Area Health Boards Amendment Act 1986, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Area Health Boards Act 1983 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

(2) Subject to **section 8 (3)** of this Act, this Act shall come into force on the day on which it receives the Governor-General's assent.

That *clauses 9 to 14* be a separate Bill, and that for *clause 9* there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and clause:

An Act to amend the Hospitals Act 1957

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1. Short Title—This Act may be cited as the Hospitals Amendment Act 1986, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Hospitals Act 1957 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).
