HEALTH ACTS AMENDMENT BILL

Proposed Motion to Divide the Bill into 3 Bills

Hon. Mr CAYGILL, in Committee, to move the following motion:

That Part I and the First Schedule be a separate Bill, and that for clause 2 there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and Short Title:

An Act to amend the Health Act 1956

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

1. **Short Title and commencement**—(1) This Act may be cited as the Health Amendment Act 1988, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Health Act 1956 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

(2) Section 4 of this Act, and the First Schedule to this Act, shall come into force on the 1st day of October 1988.

(3) Except as provided in subsection (2) of this section, this Act shall come into force on the 28th day after the date on which it receives the Governor-General's assent.

That Part II be a separate Bill, and that for clause 8 there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and Short Title:

An Act to amend the Area Health Boards Act 1983

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

1. **Short Title and commencement**—(1) This Act may be cited as the Area Health Boards Amendment Act (No. 3) 1988, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Area Health Boards Act 1983 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

(2) Sections 9A and 19A of this Act shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of April 1988.

(3) Section 13 of this Act shall come into force on the date on which this Act receives the Governor-General's assent.

(4) Except as provided in subsections (2) and (3) of this section, this Act shall come into force on the 28th day after the date on which it receives the Governor-General's assent.

That Part III and the Second Schedule be a separate Bill, and that for clause 21 there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and Short Title:

An Act to amend the Hospitals Act 1957

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

1. **Short Title and commencement**—(1) This Act may be cited as the Hospitals Amendment Act (No. 3) 1988, and shall

be read together with and deemed part of the Hospitals Act 1957 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

(2) Section 25 of this Act, so far as it substitutes sections 28 and 28A of the principal Act, shall come into force on the date on which this Act receives the Governor-General's assent.

(3) Except as provided in subsection (2) of this section, this Act shall come into force on the 28th day after the date on which it receives the Governor-General's assent.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

The motion proposes that the Bill be divided into 3 Bills, the Health Amendment Bill, the Area Health Boards Amendment Bill (No. 3), and the Hospitals Amendment (No. 3) Bill.
