HARBOURS AMENDMENT BILL.

Mr. LAURENSEN, in Committee, to move the following new clause:—

Election of
member by
members of
union of
waterside-
workers.

13A. (1.) In the case of a Harbour Board any of the members of which are elected by the payers of dues there shall, if a duly registered industrial union of waterside-workers exists in the main port under the jurisdiction of the Board, be also a member elected by the members of that union in the manner and at the time prescribed by regulations, and the member so elected shall be in addition to the members provided for in this Act, or in the case of a Board the constitution of which is hereafter fixed by a special Act then, unless provision is made for such a member in the special Act, in addition to the members provided for in that Act.

(2.) If at any time the registration of any such industrial union is cancelled under the provisions of the Industrial Conciliation and Arbitration Act, 1908, the member of the Board elected by the members of that union shall, as from the date of the gazetting of the notice of cancellation, cease to hold office as a member of the Board.
