HARBOURS AMENDMENT.

Mr. CRAIGIE, in Committee, to move the following amendments:-

Clause 7: To add the following new subclause,—

(5.) Where any borough or town district forms part of a combined district, all persons shall be entitled to vote as electors of a county or road district, or any portion thereof forming part of such combined district, for the election of a member or members of a Board, who possess a similar qualification to that possessed by an elector of such borough or district, and the electors' roll shall be compiled accordingly.

Clause 8: To add the following new subclause,—

(4.) That notwithstanding anything contained in this Act in the case of Harbour Boards having rating powers to secure the interest, or interest and sinking fund, on any loan or loans secured by a rate on land, the Chairman and members of such Boards shall be elected on the same days and shall continue in office for the same periods as before the passing of this Act. For the purpose of giving effect to this provision the Governor in Council shall have all the powers of making regulations as to the time and mode of such elections and otherwise as he deems necessary.
