HOUSING AMENDMENT BILL.

Mr. YOUNG, in Committee, to move to insert the following new clauses:—

8. Part IV of the Housing Act, 1919, is hereby amended by adding thereto the following subsections:—

“(1.) Any Electric-power Board within the meaning of the Electric-power Boards Act, 1918, may acquire land, and may erect dwellings thereon, to be disposed of by way of sale or lease, on such conditions as the Board thinks fit, to workers in the employment of that Board, or may erect dwellings to be disposed of as aforesaid on any land owned by the Board and not held in trust for any special purpose.

“(2.) The term “electric works” within the meaning of the Electric-power Boards Act, 1918, is hereby extended to include the purchase or lease of lands that may be required by any Board for the purpose of this section, and the erection and disposal of any dwellings pursuant to this section.”

9. Section fifteen of the Housing Amendment Act, 1920, is hereby amended so as to include and apply to any Electric-power Board with respect to borrowing money for the acquisition of land and the erection of workers dwellings thereon notwithstanding anything contained in the said section to the contrary.
