HARBOURS AMENDMENT BILL

Proposed Amendment

Hon. Mr Fox, in Committee, to move the following amendment:

To insert, after clause 13, the following clause:

13A. Bylaws as to bathing—Section two hundred and thirty-two of the principal Act is hereby further amended by inserting, after paragraph thirty-four, the following paragraph:
“(34A) Limit the waters of the harbour that may be utilised for bathing.”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This clause authorises a Harbour Board to make bylaws limiting the waters of the harbour under its control that may be utilised for bathing. The existing power in section 232 (34) of the principal Act relates only to the foreshore (i.e., the area between high-water and low-water marks at ordinary tides), and applies only where the foreshore is vested in or under the control of the Board.
