HOSPITALS AMENDMENT BILL

Proposed Amendments

Hon. Mr TIZARD, in Committee, to move the following amendments:

Clause 6: Proposed new subsection (5B): To omit the words “, or one that should not have been made,”.

To insert, after the words “paid shall” in line 3 on page 4, the words “, subject to any directions given by the Committee,”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

Clause 6: Proposed new subsection (5B): The first amendment omits one of the grounds on which the Review Committee may order a complainant or appellant to pay costs, namely, that the complaint or appeal is one that should not have been made.

The second amendment provides that deductions from salary to recover costs shall be subject to any directions given by the Review Committee.
