HOLIDAYS BILL

HON. MR BOLGER, in Committee, to move the following amendments:

Clause 7: To insert, after the word "Undertakings" in line 16 on page 6, the words "or factories".

Clause 30: To omit subclause (2) on page 19, and to substitute the following subclause:

(2) Nothing in sections 24, 25, and 27 of this Act shall apply to any person in respect of his employment in an undertaking if that person is subject to an award or an agreement relating to that employment, and that award or agreement confers all or any of the benefits referred to in those sections, or declares that all or any of the benefits referred to in those sections do not apply, or makes no provision for any such benefits.

Clause 37 (b): To omit the expression "1980" from line 46 on page 21, and to substitute the expression "1981".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

Clause 7: The amendment brings the provisions of the Bill into line with the proposed Factories and Commercial Premises Act 1981 as regards binding the Crown.

Clause 30: The amendment confirms that the provisions of the Bill relating to statutory holidays and Sunday work do not apply to undertakings where the employees work under an award or agreement.

Clause 37: The amendment corrects a year reference.
