HARBORS ACT 1878 AMENDMENT BILL.

Mr. Thomson, in Committee, to move the addition of the following new clause:—

The first paragraph of section three of "The Harbours Act, 1878," (hereinafter referred to as "the said Act,") is hereby repealed, and the following substituted therefor:—

Except as hereinafter provided, the several Acts and Ordinances set forth in the *First* Schedule hereto shall, immediately on this Act coming into operation, be repealed to the extent in the said Schedule mentioned.

This provision shall operate from the commencement of the said Act, as if it had originally been inserted therein.

HAWKE'S BAY AND MARLBOROUGH RIVERS ACT 1868 AMENDMENT BILL.

Mr. Collins, in Committee, to move the addition of the following new clause:—

The word "three-fourths," in the third and fourth lines of the sixth clause of "The Hawke's Bay and Marlborough Rivers Act Amendment Act, 1872," shall be struck out, and the word "one-half" be inserted in lieu thereof.

Also, to amend the Title by adding the words "and the Hawke's Bay and Marlborough Rivers Act Amendment Act, 1872."
