HOMOSEXUAL LAW REFORM BILL

Proposed Motion to Divide the Bill into 2 Separate Bills

FRAN WILDE, in Committee, to move as follows:

That *PART I* be a separate Bill, and that for clause 2 there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and Short Title:

An Act to amend the Crimes Act 1961 by removing criminal sanctions against consensual homosexual conduct between males, and by consequentially amending the law relating to consensual anal intercourse

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1. Short Title and commencement—(1) This Act may be cited as the Crimes Amendment Act (No. 2) 1986, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Crimes Act 1961 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

(2) This Act shall come into force on the 28th day after the date on which it receives the Governor-General's assent.

That *PART II*, and the Schedule, be a separate Bill, and that for clause 8 there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and Short Title:

An Act to amend the Human Rights Commission Act 1977 by rendering it unlawful to discriminate against a person on the ground of that person's sexual orientation

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1. Short Title and commencement—(1) This Act may be cited as the Human Rights Commission Amendment Act 1986, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Human Rights Commission Act 1977 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

(2) This Act shall come into force on the 28th day after it

receives the Governor-General's assent.
