HOSPITAL NURSES REGISTRATION BILL.

Hon. Mr. Hall-Jones, in Committee, to move the addition of the following new clause:—

For the purpose of enabling nurses who have had not less than four years' experience as nurses, and who do not come within the foregoing provisions, to be registered under this Act, the Minister may make regulations prescribing the qualifications or form of examination required and the fee to be paid for the issue of a certificate which shall entitle the holder to registration under this Act:

Provided that no such certificate shall be issued after the thirty-first day of December, one thousand nine hundred and two.
