HEALTH OCCUPATIONAL REGISTRATION ACTS AMENDMENT BILL

Proposed Motion to Divide the Bill into 12 separate Bills

Hon WYATT CREECH, in Committee, to move as follows:

That *Part 1* and *Schedule 1* be a separate Bill, and that for *clause 2* and the heading above that clause there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and clause:

An Act to amend the Chiropractors Act 1982

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

1. Short Title and commencement—(1) This Act may be cited as the Chiropractors Amendment Act 1999, and is part of the Chiropractors Act 1982 (“the principal Act”).

(2) This Act comes into force on the 7th day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.

That *Part 2* and *Schedule 2* be a separate Bill, and that for *clause 10* and the heading above that clause there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and clause:

An Act to amend the Dental Act 1988

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

1. Short Title and commencement—(1) This Act may be cited as the Dental Amendment Act 1999, and is part of the Dental Act 1988 (“the principal Act”).

(2) This Act comes into force on the 7th day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.

That *Part 3* and *Schedule 3* be a separate Bill, and that for *clause 15* and the heading above that clause there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and clause:

An Act to amend the Dietitians Act 1950

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

1. Short Title and commencement—(1) This Act may be cited as the Dietitians Amendment Act 1999, and is part of the Dietitians Act 1950 (“the principal Act”).

(2) This Act comes into force on the 7th day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.

That *Part 4* and *Schedule 4* be a separate Bill, and that for *clause 24* and the heading above that clause there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and clause:

An Act to amend the Medical Auxiliaries Act 1966

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

1. Short Title and commencement—(1) This Act may be cited as the Medical Auxiliaries Amendment Act 1999, and is part of the Medical Auxiliaries Act 1966 (“the principal Act”).

(2) This Act comes into force on the 7th day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.

That *Part 5* be a separate Bill, and that for *clause 36* and the heading above that clause there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and clause:

An Act to amend the Medical Practitioners Act 1995

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

1. Short Title and commencement—(1) This Act may be cited as the Medical Practitioners Amendment Act 1999, and is part of the Medical Practitioners Act 1995 (“the principal Act”).

(2) This Act comes into force on the 7th day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.

That *Part 6* and *Schedule 5* be a separate Bill, and that for *clause 39* and the heading above that clause there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and clause:

An Act to amend the Nurses Act 1977

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

1. Short Title and commencement—(1) This Act may be cited as the Nurses Amendment Act 1999, and is part of the Nurses Act 1977 (“the principal Act”).

(2) This Act comes into force on the 7th day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.

That *Part 7* and *Schedule 6* be a separate Bill, and that for *clause 41* and the heading above that clause there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and clause:

An Act to amend the Occupational Therapy Act 1949

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

1. Short Title and commencement—(1) This Act may be cited as the Occupational Therapy Amendment Act 1999, and is part of the Occupational Therapy Act 1949 (“the principal Act”).

(2) This Act comes into force on the 7th day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.

That *Part 8* and *Schedule 7* be a separate Bill, and that for *clause 52* and the heading above that clause there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and clause:

An Act to amend the Optometrists and Dispensing Opticians Act 1976

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

1. Short Title and commencement—(1) This Act may be cited as the Optometrists and Dispensing Opticians Amendment Act 1999, and is part of the Optometrists and Dispensing Opticians Act 1976 (“the principal Act”).

(2) This Act comes into force on the 7th day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.

That *Part 8A* and *Schedule 7A* be a separate Bill, and that for *clause 59D* and the heading above that clause there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and clause:

An Act to amend the Pharmacy Act 1970

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

1. Short Title and commencement—(1) This Act may be cited as the Pharmacy Amendment Act 1999, and is part of the Pharmacy Act 1970 (“the principal Act”).

(2) This Act comes into force on the 7th day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.

That *Part 9* and *Schedule 8* be a separate Bill, and that for *clause 60* and the heading above that clause there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and clause:

An Act to amend the Physiotherapy Act 1949

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

1. Short Title and commencement—(1) This Act may be cited as the Physiotherapy Amendment Act 1999, and is part of the Physiotherapy Act 1949 (“the principal Act”).

(2) This Act comes into force on the 7th day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.

That *Part 10* and *Schedule 8A* be a separate Bill, and that for *clause 71* and the heading above that clause there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and clause:

An Act to amend the Plumbers, Gasfitters, and Drainlayers Act 1976

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

1. Short Title and commencement—(1) This Act may be cited as the Plumbers, Gasfitters, and Drainlayers Amendment Act 1999, and is part of the Plumbers, Gasfitters, and Drainlayers Act 1976 (“the principal Act”).

(2) This Act comes into force on the 7th day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.

That *Part 11* and *Schedule 9* be a separate Bill, and that for *clause 73* and the heading above that clause there be substituted the following Title, enacting words, and clause:

An Act to amend the Psychologists Act 1981

BE IT ENACTED by the Parliament of New Zealand as follows:

1. Short Title and commencement—(1) This Act may be cited as the Psychologists Amendment Act 1999, and is part of the Psychologists Act 1981 (“the principal Act”).

(2) This Act comes into force on the 7th day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.
