Historic Places Amendment Bill

Proposed amendments

Sue Kedgley, in Committee, to move the following amendments:

Clause 16

New section 37: to omit “subsection (9)(a)” and substitute:

- “(a) the Trust must apply section 194 of the Resource Management Act 1991 until the Trust has finally dealt with the application, as if the application were a notice of a requirement for a heritage order unless the Trust can demonstrate that the application of section 194 of the Resource Management Act 1991 would risk the productive working relationships between the Trust and property owners; and”

Clause 19

New section 42: to insert in subsection (3) after “must” (line 28, page 12) “be Maori and”.

Explanatory note

This Supplementary Order Paper contains amendments to the Historic Places Amendment Bill. The amendments seek to:

- restore protection measures for historic places undergoing a category review while continuing to offer the Historic Places Trust Board discretion in applying protection measures in the cases where the productive working relationships between the Trust and property owners are put at risk;
- re-establishes the requirement that three of the Historic Places Trust Board members be Māori in line with the recommendations of the Historic Places

Trust made in their submission to the Government Administration
Committee.
