Health Practitioners Competence Assurance Bill

Proposed motion to divide Bill into 3 Bills

Hon Annette King, in Committee, to move as follows:

That the enacting words, *clause 1*, *Parts 1 to 7*, and *Schedules 1 to 8* be a separate Bill, and that for the enacting words, *clause 1*, the heading to *Part 1* and *clause 2* there be substituted the following enacting words, clauses, and heading:

The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

1 Title

This Act is the Health Practitioners Competence Assurance Act 2003.

Part 1 Preliminary and key provisions

Preliminary provisions

2 Commencement

- (1) This section and **sections 1, 5, 6, and 214A** come into force on the day on which this Act receives the Royal assent.
- (2) Sections 50 to 60, and 169 come into force on the 28th day after the date on which this Act receives the Royal assent.
- (3) Sections 10 to 13, section 110(1A) to (4), sections 111 to 113, section 114(a), sections 115 to 118, and clauses 1 to 16 of Schedule 3 come into force on the day that is 3 months after the date on which this Act receives the Royal assent.
- (4) The amendments in Schedule 4 to the Health and Disability Commissioner Act 1994 and to the Social Workers Registration Act 2003 (other than to section 4 of the latter Act) come into force—
 - (a) on the day that is 12 months after the date on which this Act receives the Royal assent if section 59 of the Social

Workers Registration Act 2003 is in force on that day; or

- (b) if section 59 of the Social Workers Registration Act 2003 is not in force on that day, then on the day on which that section comes into force.
- (5) The rest of this Act comes into force on the day that is 1 year after the date on which this Act receives the Royal assent.

That *Part 8* be a separate Bill, and that for the heading to *Part 8* and *clause 219* there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

- 1 Title
- (1) This Act is the Health and Disability Commissioner Amendment Act **2003**.
- (2) In this Act, the Health and Disability Commissioner Act 1994 is called "the principal Act".

2 Commencement

This Act comes into force on the day that is 1 year after the date on which this Act receives the Royal assent.

That *Part 9* be a separate Bill, and that for the heading to *Part 9* and *clause 239* there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

- 1 Title
- (1) This Act is the Medicines Amendment Act 2003.
- (2) In this Act, the Medicines Act 1981 is called "the principal Act".

2 Commencement

This Act comes into force on the day that is 1 year after the date on which this Act receives the Royal assent.
