Health Practitioners Competence Assurance Bill

Proposed amendment

Heather Roy, in committee to move the following amendment:

Clause 254: new section 105(C):

To omit subsection (2) (lines 1 to 10 on page 186), and substitute the following subsection:

- “(2) The Minister must not recommend the making of any Order in Council under **subsection (1)** unless the Minister is satisfied that making that Order in Council will—
- “(a) improve health services or improve access to those health services; and
 - “(b) not result in either a District Health Board or a Primary Health Organisation directly or indirectly investing in or taking shares in that pharmacy, or directly or indirectly taking a role in managing or controlling the operation of that pharmacy; with the exception of when a District Health Board establishes, owns, or is responsible for the management or control of a pharmacy carried on, on a not for profit basis, in a hospital under its direct control; and
 - “(c) not result in either a District Health Board or a Primary Health Organisation directly or indirectly accepting any financial liability for the operation of that pharmacy, with the exception of when a District Health Board establishes, owns or is responsible for the management or control of a pharmacy carried on, on a not for profit basis, in a hospital under its direct control; and
 - “(d) result in that pharmacy complying with all other requirements of this Act.”
