Human Rights Amendment Bill

Proposed motion to divide Bill into 2 Bills

Hon Margaret Wilson, in Committee, to move as follows:

That the enacting words, *clauses 1 and 2*, *Parts 1 and 3*, *and Schedules 1 to 3* be a separate Bill, and that for the enacting words and clauses 1 and 2 there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

- 1 Title
- (1) This Act is the Human Rights Amendment Act 2001.
- (2) In this Act, the Human Rights Act 1993 is called "the principal Act".
- 2 Commencement
- (1) This Act comes into force on **1 January 2002**.
- (2) Despite subsection (1), sections 8(1)(ba), 13A, 14(1)(da), and 15A of the principal Act (as inserted by section 5 of this Act) and section 141A(2) of the principal Act (as inserted by section 33A of this Act) come into force on 1 July 2002.

That *Part 2* be a separate Bill, and that for the *Part 2* heading, *clause 40*, and the heading above *clause 41* there be substituted the following enacting words and clauses:

The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

- 1 Title
- (1) This Act is the War Pensions Amendment Act 2001.
- (2) In this Act, the War Pensions Act 1954 is called "the principal Act".
